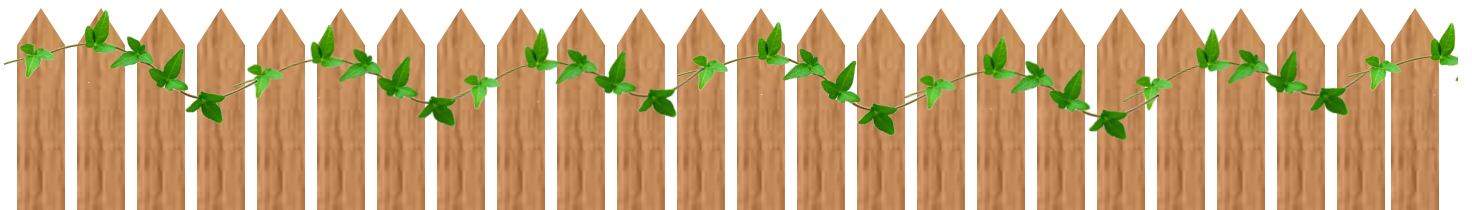

The Langley Garden Club History

Founded in 1941

The Langley Garden Club started as an outgrowth of the Agricultural Association. Various exhibitors of the Annual Fall Fair formed the Club. Laurens Dence, who was a strong supporter of the children's gardens, was instrumental in starting an adult club. Members first gathered in each others' homes and as membership grew, various halls were used, such as the Anglican Church Hall, United Church Hall and the Langley Central School Activity Room.

The highlight of the year was the annual show held in the Church Hall and the Willoughby Community Hall. The first award was presented to Mrs. Dence in 1941 by Burns Lyttleton for Floral Arrangements and in 1949 the Dence Cup was first awarded. These trophies were passed on to the Garden Club by the Agricultural Association.

In 1979, the Anglican Church and Hall were devastated by fire and we lost all our records and library books. We then moved to the Sharon United Church Hall in Murrayville, where we held our meetings for 20 years, followed by a number of years at the Murrayville Hall, and have now returned to the United Churches of Langley (formerly the Sharon United Church)

At each meeting there is a Parlour Show and Special Shows during the year. We also continue to have our annual Spring Show with a Plant and Bake Sale each April.

FLORAL ARTS DEFINITIONS

ARRANGEMENT: a floral arrangement consists of fresh-cut plant material in a container with a base if necessary.

COMPOSITION: may consist of dried, weathered, or artificially treated material and/or accessories with or without fresh-cut plant material, (**no silks**)

DESIGN: may be either an arrangement or a composition.

VASE: taller than its width.

BOWL: opening is wider than its height.

BASKET: can be made of any material but must have a handle

ADVANCED/INTERMEDIATE/NOVICE: you may enter according to your ability

NR - NOT RESTRICTED : artificially altered materials allowed (incl. dyed, glittered...)

SHOW RULES

This will be a non-juried show (except Floral Arts)

We encourage you to bring as many entries as you wish - creating a mass of colour and beauty in the hall! (Similar to our regular Show and Tell style at the monthly meetings)

1. The Show is open to members & their family, including children and grandchildren. All entries must be grown by the exhibitor, exceptions are: house plants which must be owned for more than three months and material used in decorative exhibits.
2. Exhibits must be staged between **5:00 - 6:45 pm, Friday April 25, 2025**
CLOSING DATE FOR GENERAL ENTRIES IS: 6:45 pm Friday April 25, 2025
FLORAL ART ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED by 5pm Thursday, April 24, 2025 with Betty Girard at br.girard@telus.net
3. Judging for Floral Arts will commence **Friday, April 25^h at 7 pm sharp.**

4. All of the Judge's decisions will be considered final in Floral Arts. Judges may withhold prizes from exhibits which are considered to be of insufficient merit.
5. No exhibits may be removed before 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 26th.
6. The Langley Garden Club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to exhibitors' containers or effects and exhibitors must reclaim their exhibits promptly at the close of the show.
7. The Club reserves the right to refuse or accept any entry.
8. Exhibitors must provide their own containers and name of plant wherever possible.
